Spinal screening notice to parents

Dear Parents,

When we had the vision & hearing screenings the week of November, I was not able to do the spinal screening. It will be conducted on Feb 9th – Feb 12th the students will be screened during their Physical Education (PE) class period. **Only 6th and 9th grades need to be screened for spinal.**


The Purpose of spinal screening is to detect the signs of abnormal curves of the spine at their earliest stages so that the need of treatment can be determined. The state of Texas only requires that 6th & 9th be screened.


The screening procedure takes about 30 seconds, but does require the student to remove his/her shirt or blouse in order that the spine can be visually observed by the school nurse. For this examination, boys and girls will be seen separately and individually.

If a deviation from normal is suspected, you will be notified and requested to take your child to a physician for professional evaluation.

If your child has been recently screened, please submit to school the copy of the report. Or, if you prefer not to have your child screened for spinal curvature, please submit a letter to the school explaining the reason, and your child will exempt.

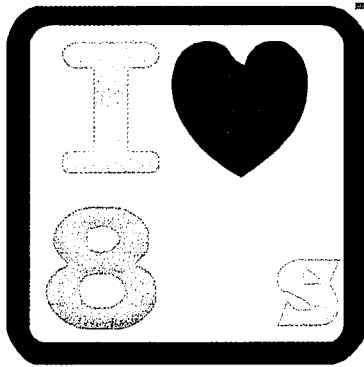

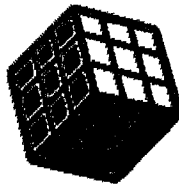
